

**MINUTES, June 20, 2011, BOWLER BOARD OF EDUCATION,  
STOCKBRIDGE-MUNSEE TRIBAL COUNCIL & EDUCATION BOARD**

Board approved 7-18-11

Call to order:

The meeting was called to order by Board President, Deb Roth, at 6:00 p.m. It was certified that the meeting was given proper notice. Roll call was taken with the following board members present: Butterfield-Boldig, Fuerst, Herzberg, Long, Martin, and Roth. Grosskopf arrived at 6:15 p.m. Also present were Scott G. 1. Policy LA-Indian Policies and Procedures

Copies of the current policy were distributed. Review of the IPP and discussion followed. No input was given at this time.

2. Title VII

Mr. DePerry provided handouts regarding the Title VII position and his responsibilities. Discussion followed.

3. Attendance and Truancy Concerns

Mrs. Munsey reported for the elementary and Mr. Peterson reported in Mrs. Gagnon's absence. Ideas were exchanged to improve on this. It was agreed upon that everyone needs to work together to improve truancy rates and parents involvement in school.

4. Review of Successful School Activities and Programs

Mrs. Munsey reviewed successful elementary programs including the Bowler Broadcast, Open House, Mohican Language Class, Smartboards, Family Nights, Language Grant, and future programs which she would like to implement. Mr. Peterson handed out information provided by Mrs. Gagnon. It was noted that very positive comments were included.

5. Other

Mr. DePerry provided Tribal Council members with information regarding the cost of the new gym floor and scoreboards. He asked if the Tribe would be willing to partner with the school and purchase advertising on the new scoreboards. The Tribal Council will take this under advisement. Joe Miller asked if a new sound system is being considered for the gym. Glenda Butterfield-Boldig thanked the Council Members for opening up the fitness center to the community.
