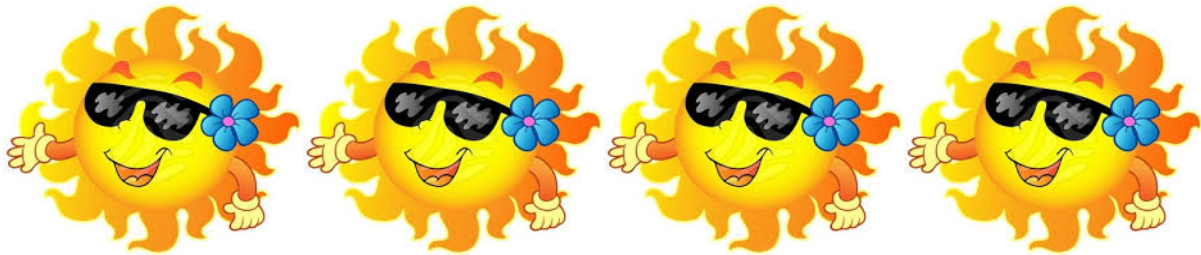


# Be Sure Not to Fizzle When the Summer Starts to Sizzle

If a class runs the entire summer school, this stipulation will obviously not be required. For **MS remedial classes**, there will still be **two sessions**.

Current Grades K-4

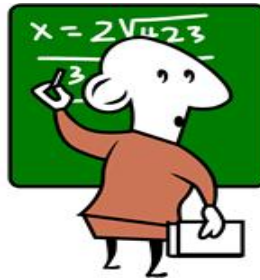

Current Grades 3-6

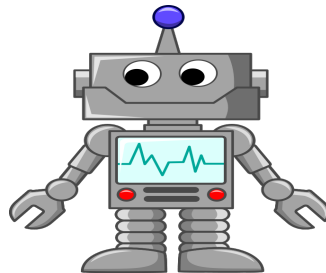

Students earn points through attendance, participation and behavior. Top scoring students will receive tickets to Packers Family Night. This has been a very popular class at Bowler through the years.

## Remedial Language Arts/Reading

Currently in Grades 7-8

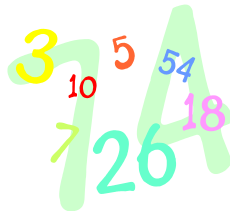

## Remedial Math

## Credit Recovery Class

Grades Levels 7-12

The alternative education program is for students who have not been successful in the regular classroom and/or have a need for an alternative approach. Students who have failed or done poorly can work with the alternative ed. staff to make up any missed credits. Independent study, E2020 courses, and small group work may be utilized.

## Driver's Education (\$275)

Current 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> graders

Driver's Education is dedicated to the idea of helping students to save lives. You will learn the basic skills of car control and various maneuvers you will use while driving. You will learn about the traffic laws that regulate driving along with the signs and signals that cue you as you drive. The course includes classroom and behind the wheel experience. You will take the temporary license test in the classroom. Class will be held upstairs in the high school, room #577. The session will run from June 13 to July 14, Mondays through Thursdays from 8:15 - 11:20 a.m., with no school on Fridays. You may sign-up for a ride home from class if you choose not to take an afternoon class. Behind the Wheel Driver's Education will be offered only during the school year.

**No credit:** Cost is \$275 payable before you get your temporary license, unless you will be taking Behind the Wheel Training at another school.
